



- Green Slow → First time on skis.
- Green Medium → Cautious wedge stance on easiest terrain.
- Green Fast → Round wedge turns on easiest green trails.
- Blue Slow → Controlled wedge turn with a parallel, skidded finish,
- Blue Medium → Parallel on easy blue trails using medium size wedge turns.
- Blue Fast → Blue trails, using a slight wedge with a parallel finish.
- Black Slow → Parallel on black trails in small bumps and can ski larger bumps with frequent stops.
- Black Medium → Good technique on all terrain with short carved parallel turns.
- Black Fast → Extreme skiing. Can make non-stop turns in bumps and powder. Ski the fall line.
